ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR PRECINCT ELECTION OFFICIALS

WHEREAS, according to Iowa Code Section 49.20, the Board of Supervisors establishes the compensation rate and mileage reimbursement rate of precinct election officials; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Muscatine County Board of Supervisors, that effective July 13, 2026, Precinct Election Chairpersons shall receive \$200.00. Precinct Election Day Officials shall receive \$160.00 for full day duties or \$80.00 for half day duties. All other Precinct Election workers, such as Absentee and Special Voter Precinct Board (ASVP), Health Care Facility (HCF) team and Post-Election Audit Workers will receive \$12.00 per hour. All Precinct Election Officials (PEO) will receive \$25.00 for election school of instruction if the PEO works on election day or for the ASVP Board, HCF team or Post-Election Audit team.

WHEREAS, according to Iowa Code Section 49.125, the Board of Supervisors establishes the mileage reimbursement rate for precinct election officials.

All Precinct Election workers will receive mileage reimbursement rate, to and from the school of instruction and to and from the polling place, if over five miles, which shall be set at \$0.63 per mile for fiscal year 2027.

MIDWEST HIGH INTENSITY DRUG TRAFFICKING AREA (HIDTA)

SUB AWARD RECIPIENT AGREEMENT

This sub award recipient agreement is entered into by and between the Iowa Department of Public Safety (the “Grantor”) and Muscatine County Sheriff’s Office (the “Subrecipient”) and is effective January 1, 2026.

Purpose

The Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) has awarded High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) funding to federal, state and local law enforcement agencies in the region comprised of the states of Kansas, Missouri, Nebraska, Iowa, Illinois, South Dakota and North Dakota for the purpose of combating the manufacture, importation and distribution of methamphetamine and illegal drugs. The Iowa Department of Public Safety (DPS) has been designated as the fiscal agent for award proceeds to be distributed to the state and local agencies participating in the Midwest HIDTA program within Iowa and in selected regional initiatives. These funds shall be used for the purposes designated in the Muscatine Task Force Initiative proposal and the associated budget, as approved by ONDCP for award HID1426G0714.

Scope of Service

The services carried out under this agreement shall be consistent with those contained in the initiative proposal and budget as approved for funding by ONDCP. Changes shall not be made in the subject or the proposed objectives of the initiative without prior written approval from the Midwest HIDTA Executive Committee and Director.

Reprogramming of Funds

Reprogramming of funds within a HIDTA award requires different levels of approval based upon the amount to be reprogrammed and whether the reprogramming is inter-agency or inter-initiative. In all cases, the Muscatine County Sheriff’s Office shall forward a request to the Midwest HIDTA Coordinator and forward the recommendation along with the appropriate reprogramming form to the Midwest HIDTA Executive Director and Midwest HIDTA Executive Committee for their review. The participating agency is responsible for maintaining detailed records of any reprogramming activities. Expenses shall not be incurred prior to receiving authorization from the Iowa HIDTA Coordinator.

Invoicing

The Subrecipient shall invoice the Iowa Department of Public Safety once a month for expenses paid during the prior month. The Subrecipient shall submit one original signed invoice along with a copy of the Detailed Expenditure Worksheet (DEW) and supportive documentation to the Iowa Department of Public Safety for reimbursement. Supportive documentation shall consist of an overtime summary, timesheets, invoices and proof of payment. The overtime summary sheet must list the law enforcement officer’s name, date worked, HIDTA case number (if applicable), number of hours worked, hourly rate and the amount of reimbursement for each law enforcement officer.

Reporting Requirements

All participants may be required to prepare a final report of their agency's expenditures, which shall be submitted to the Midwest HIDTA Coordinator within 30 days of close of the program fiscal year. Failure to submit reports on a timely basis may result in the interruption or termination of the initiative funding for your agency.

Standards and Assurances

The Subrecipient will comply with all standards and rules defined in the HIDTA Program Policy and all formal written program guidance regarding financial management standards, reporting, records retention, equipment, vehicles, procurement and supplanting. Updated program policy will be furnished to each participant as it is received from HIDTA or ONDCP.

The Subrecipient must maintain a financial management system which records all grant related costs following generally accepted accounting procedures. Adequate documentation for all contract costs must be maintained.

Any modifications or amendments to this Agreement shall be in writing and approved by both Parties.

Muscatine County Board of Supervisors
Monday, July 6, 2026

The Muscatine County Board of Supervisors met in regular session at 9:00 A.M. with Chick, Kirchner, Sauer and Sorensen present. Mather was absent. Chairperson Chick presiding.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the agenda was approved as presented. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Kirchner, the Board approved claims dated July 6, 2026 in the amount of \$538,667.65. Ayes: All.

The Board discussed ongoing safety concerns at several rural intersections, with particular focus on the intersections of Highway 6 and Moscow Road (X54) and Highway 38 and 155th Street (F70) following multiple recent serious injury crashes. County Sheriff Quinn Riess stated that several significant accidents have occurred at the intersections within the past few months, prompting increased concern from both emergency responders and the public. It was reported that County Engineer Brian Horesowsky had previously applied to the Iowa Department of Transportation (DOT) requesting approval to install flashing stop sign beacons; however, the approval process has been delayed pending further Iowa DOT review. Board members emphasized that while flashing stop signs may not eliminate crashes, they represent a reasonable and cost-effective safety measure worth pursuing. The consensus was that the County should continue advocating for approval rather than allowing the issue to remain unresolved.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the Board authorized the Chair to sign a letter regarding flashing lights on stop signs at rural intersections. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the Board approved the Contract, Bond and Certificate of Insurance for L-(26-10)--73-70, Seal Coat on various roadways. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Kirchner, second by Sauer, the Board approved the minutes of the June 29, 2026 regular meeting. Ayes: All.

Correspondence:

Sauer received a call from a citizen regarding the intersection of Stewart Road and Pettibone. Sauer stated that he spoke with Horesowsky and was advised that the intersection will likely not reopen until sometime in August.

Chick had an email exchange with Autumn Harris regarding the solar farms that are being built and letters being sent out to selected individuals. County Development Director Eric Furnas stated that his recollection was that individuals that reside within a one-mile radius of a solar farm would be receiving a letter.

Committee Reports:

No meetings were reported.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the Board authorized the Chair to sign a three-year contract with Cost Advisory Services, Inc. in the amount of \$6,580/year for FY25/26, FY26/27 and FY27/28 cost allocation services. Ayes: All.

On a motion by Sorensen, second by Sauer, the Board approved Resolution #07-06-26-01 Authorizing and Approving a Loan Agreement and Providing for the Issuance of a \$225,000 General Obligation County Purpose Note and Providing for the Levy of Taxes to Pay the Same. Roll call vote: Ayes: All.

RESOLUTION #07-06-26-01
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING A LOAN AGREEMENT AND PROVIDING FOR
THE ISSUANCE OF A \$225,000 GENERAL OBLIGATION COUNTY PURPOSE NOTE
AND PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF TAXES TO PAY THE SAME

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (the “Board”) of Muscatine County, Iowa (the “County”) proposed to enter into a General Obligation Loan Agreement (the “Loan Agreement”) and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$225,000, pursuant to the provisions of Section 331.402 of the Code of Iowa, for the purpose of paying the cost, to that extent, of constructing, furnishing & equipping a satellite building for the County Engineer’s Office, and pursuant to law and duly published notice of the proposed action has held a hearing thereon on June 15, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Board has authorized a certain bid sheet and term letter for use in negotiating the Loan Agreement and providing for the private placement of a \$225,000 General Obligation County Purpose Note, Series 2026 (the “Note”) to be issued in evidence of the obligation under the Loan Agreement; and

WHEREAS, proposals for the placement of the Note to be issued in evidence of the County’s obligation under the Loan Agreement have been received and reviewed; and

WHEREAS, upon due consideration of the proposals, the private placement proposal of CBI Bank & Trust, Muscatine, Iowa (the “Lender”), is the best, such bid proposing the most favorable terms to the County for the Note; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to make final provision for the approval of the Loan Agreement and to authorize the issuance of the Note;

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Muscatine County, Iowa, as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the County shall enter into the Loan Agreement with the Lender, in substantially the form which has been placed on file with the County, providing for a loan to the County in the amount of \$225,000 for the purpose or purposes as set forth in the preamble hereof.

The Chairperson and County Auditor are hereby authorized and directed to sign the Loan Agreement on behalf of the County, and the Loan Agreement is hereby approved.

Section 2. The Note is hereby authorized to be issued in evidence of the obligation of the County under the Loan Agreement in the principal amount of \$225,000, and shall be dated as of the date of delivery to the Lender (anticipated to be July 27, 2026). Principal of the Note shall be payable in five (5) annual installments, payable on June 1 in each of the years, in the respective principal amounts, as follows:

Section 3. The County Auditor is hereby designated as the registrar and paying agent for the Note and may be hereinafter referred to as the “Registrar” or the “Paying Agent.”

Principal of the Note shall bear interest at the rate of 3.75% per annum from the date of the Note. Accrued interest on the Note shall be payable semiannually on the first day of June and December in each year, commencing December 1, 2026, and continuing to, and including, final maturity on June 1, 2031. Interest shall be calculated on the basis of a 360-day year comprised of twelve 30-day months.

Payment of both principal of and interest on the Note shall be made to the registered owners appearing on the registration books of the County at the close of business on the fifteenth day of the month next preceding the interest payment date and shall be paid to the registered owners at the addresses shown on such registration books. Principal of the Note shall be payable in lawful money of the United States of America to the registered owners or their legal representatives upon presentation and surrender of the Note at the office of the Paying Agent.

The County reserves the right to prepay principal of the Note in whole or in part on any date prior to maturity upon terms of par and accrued interest. All principal so prepaid shall cease to bear interest on the prepayment date.

The Note shall be executed on behalf of the County with the official manual or facsimile signature of the Chairperson and attested with the official manual or facsimile signature of the County Auditor and shall be fully registered Note without interest coupons. In case any officer whose signature or the facsimile of whose signature appears on the Note shall cease to be such officer before the delivery of the Note, such signature or such facsimile signature shall nevertheless be valid and sufficient for all purposes, the same as if such officer had remained in office until delivery.

The Note shall be fully registered as to principal and interest in the names of the owners on the registration books of the County kept by the Registrar, and after such registration, payment of the principal thereof and interest thereon shall be made only to the registered owners or their legal representatives or assigns. The Note shall be transferable only upon the registration books of the County upon presentation to the Registrar, together with either a written instrument of transfer satisfactory to the Registrar or the assignment form thereon completed and duly executed by the registered owner or the duly authorized attorney for such registered owner.

The record and identity of the owners of the Note shall be kept confidential as provided by Section 22.7 of the Code of Iowa.

Any amount received by the County as accrued interest on the Note shall be deposited into such special account and used to pay interest due on the Note on the first interest payment date.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 76.4 of the Code of Iowa, each year while the Note remain outstanding and unpaid, any funds of the County which may lawfully be applied for such purpose, may be appropriated, budgeted and, if received, used for the payment of the principal of and interest on the Note as the same become due, and if so appropriated, the taxes for any given fiscal year as provided for in Section 7 of this Resolution, shall be reduced by the amount of such alternate funds as have been appropriated for said purpose and evidenced in the County's budget.

Section 9. The interest or principal and both of them falling due in any year or years shall, if necessary, be paid promptly from current funds on hand in advance of taxes levied and when the taxes shall have been collected, reimbursement shall be made to such current funds in the sum thus advanced.

Section 10. It is the intention of the County that interest on the Note be and remain excluded from gross income for federal income tax purposes pursuant to the appropriate provisions of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the Treasury Regulations in effect with respect thereto (all of the foregoing herein referred to as the "Internal Revenue Code"). Naber reported that the General Basic Fund ended approximately \$2.6 million over budget, primarily due to higher-than-anticipated interest earnings and federal revenue. The Secondary Roads Fund finished approximately \$2.2 million over budget as a result of the timing of road projects and equipment purchases carrying over between fiscal years. All remaining fund balances were reported to be near budgeted estimates. Naber noted that the General Basic Fund currently maintains a 35% fund balance, which is the maximum allowed under new state legislation, and discussed the option of transferring approximately \$850,000 to another fund to reduce the balance to 30% or retaining the current balance. Sorensen recommended maintaining the 35% fund balance due to uncertainty surrounding the implementation and long-term impacts of recent legislative changes, including limitations on general fund growth and taxation. Naber stated that funds could be transferred later in the fiscal year if warranted once additional guidance and revenue trends become clearer.
